System for payment

- Primary 1-3 pupils whose families are in receipt of a clothing grant can attend breakfast club free of charge.
- Primary 4-7 pupils entitled to a free school meal can attend breakfast club free of charge.
- Any pupil not eligible for a free breakfast, a charge of £2 per day is required.
- For families, the oldest child pays £2 and subsequent siblings will be charged £1.
- The preferred method of payment is our online payment facility, Parentpay.
- If your child is unable to attend there will be no charge

Application Process

All applications for entry into Breakfast Club should be submitted in writing. Forms are available at the school office.

Any children currently enrolled in breakfast club will maintain their place the following session.

Aims

- Offer a nutritional and healthy breakfast prior to the start of the school day.
- Encourage good eating habits and a positive attitude towards healthy eating in our pupils from a young age.
- Encourage pupils to attend school on time, eat a healthy breakfast and attend class ready to learn.
- Encourage social interaction among children and between staff and children.
- Provide parents with the opportunity to work more flexibly.
- Provide a safe, nurturing and stimulating environment.

Attendance

It is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure safe arrival at breakfast club. Schools will be unable to identify absence until the class teacher completes the register just after 9am.

If your child does not attend Breakfast
Club for a period of three weeks without
explanation, a member of school staff
will make contact by phone with a letter
to follow. If unexplained absence
continues for a further week, the child
will be removed from the register.

Operational Guidance

Breakfast club staff will be responsible for the safety of pupils.

If there is an opportunity for outdoor play, this will be supervised by club staff.

Children attending the Breakfast Club will remain supervised until the school bell at 9am.

Breakfast Club can be accessed up until 8.30am.

- Children are calm, focused and ready to start the school day.
- Children develop an appreciation of the social values and of eating with others
- Children develop an understanding of the etiquette and manners expected when eating in company.
- An inclusive environment with respect to gender, ethnicity, religion and disability.
